Nordic Shelter Managers for Winter 2019 – Expressions of Interest

The Nordic Shelter Management Committee are seeking expressions of interest by persons interested in managing the Nordic Shelter located in Perisher Valley. Managing the Nordic Shelter at the Perisher XC Centre is one of the more interesting ways to fill a winter. It has to be emphasised that the position is a volunteer position and the Committee has no objections to alternate employment, however it must not interfere with the appointed manager fulfilling the Nordic Shelter Manager's duties. * Please indicate in your EOI application, if you intend to have alternative employment during the winter. While the duties are partly outlined below, they will be further defined during the selection process. It is important to note that the manager's duties and responsibilities on many occasions requires 2 people to complete all tasks, particularly in adverse weather conditions.

However as the Nordic Shelter Manager, you will have a winter like no other.

Accommodation is provided at the Nordic Shelter for two people and the manager/s are required to be in residence from the June long weekend through the October long weekend. A contribution of \$500 is given to the manager to offset some of the costs associated with being at the Nordic Shelter during the winter. A parking space is provided in Smiggins.

Duties of the Managers include (but aren't limited to):

- Day-to-day management of the facility in regard to the public use of the building – opening/closing, cleaning, supplies, snow control (and other safety issues) and maintenance as required.
- Daily reporting and communication of snow/weather/trail conditions and information about events and activities at the XC Centre.
- Working with NPWS and the contract groomer to co-ordinate XC trail grooming on a daily basis.
- Trail grooming – skidoo.
- Working with NSWXC and other groups to facilitate events, fundraising activities and projects.

Useful skills:

- Familiarity with the varied issues of snow grooming.
- Experienced XC skier
- Practical mechanical and building maintenance.
- Experienced skidoo driver.
- Computer and communication.
- First aid.
- Strong Interpersonal skills to be flexible, adaptable and ability to be cheerful in trying circumstances.

Expressions of interest in the position are requested by 15 February 2019. Please include your contact details, a resume to support your application addressing the selection criteria about your suitability for the role (and other comments that you may wish to make) and 2 relevant referees to support your application. The successful applicant will be appointed as the Nordic Shelter Manager for the 2019 Season.
